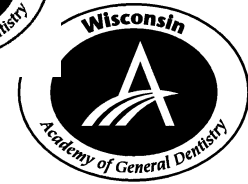

Mastership Passport and Master's Continuum

Speaker Biography

Dr. Warshawsky is a graduate of the University of Illinois. He started his practice in 1992 & currently owns & operates 4 offices in & around Chicago. He served as craniofacial orthodontist for the Unuversity of Chicago until July 2006. He focuses on esthetic solutions for multidisciplinary dental cases, & is currently one of the largest users of Ibraces, custom made lingual braces, in North & South America. He speaks professionally on lingual orthodontics, removable appliance therapy & dental technology specifically related to orthodontics. When he is not working, he may be found with his high-school sweetheart & his 3 children in his cabin in the Wisconsin North Woods.

Course Summary

This course will discuss trends in customized patient orthodontic care on 2 levels, both fixed & removable. What is hot & what is fantasy, & you may be surprised which is which. The orthodontic world is on the verge of a major regensis. As our approach goes from 2-dimensional acetate tracings to 3-dimensional custom made analyses & appliances, the focus of correction will be able to hone in on individual patient needs. Digital photography, cone beam technology, electronic models, friction free bracket systems, temporary anchorage devices, robotically bent arch wires, computer aided indirect bonding trays, these are just a few of the new tools available.

The second half of our course will focus on what can be done when patients only require minor tooth movement. These patients are already in every practice, they just do not realize that you can help them, Many pratitioners do not see these individuals as potential orthodontic candidates within their own office. We will discuss how to identify these "found income" patients, the limits of what these mechanics can predictably deliver, who to choose to use them, & how to employ mechanics. By the end of the second day the practitioner will be competent to make a removable clear Essix retainer for minor tooth movement.

This program is generously supported by Raintree Essix, a Dentsply company. A representative will be on hand both days to answer questions & assist the doctors in honing their technique.

Participants are required to bring at least one model of their own teeth to participate in this course. Participants are encouraged to bring in additional case models, so they may be worked up by the entire class.

2. Understand retainers & minor tooth movement
3. Understand cone beam technology, robotic built wires, friction free brackets & software.
4. Understand the 6 ways to create tooth movement with an Essix retainer,
