Dr. Izchak Barzilay received his DDS from the University of Toronto in 1983, a Certificate in Prosthodontics from the Eastman Dental Center in Rochester, NY in 1986, and a MS from the University of Rochester in 1991. He is currently Head of the Division of Prosthodontics and Restorative Dentistry, Mt. Sinai Hospital, Toronto, Ont.; Assistant Professor, University of Toronto; Adjunct Professor, Division of Prosthodontics of the Eastman Department of Dentistry, University of Rochester, NY; Professor, George Brown College of Applied Arts and Technology, Toronto. Dr. Barzilay is in private practice, limited to prosthodontics and implant dentistry. He has published on various topics including immediate implants and is the recipient of several awards, as well as a holder of fellowships in the Academy of Prosthodontics, Academy of Osseointegration, Pierre Fauchard Academy and the Academy of Dentistry International.

He joined the Henry Schein company in November 2007 and became the company's E4D specialist. His focus, as a dental representative, has always been digital technology, both in radiology and in CAD/CAM. At present, he serves as COO and co-founder of NOVO Dental Studios.



TOPIC

The focus of the lectures is "A Digital Practice". What is it? A digital practice makes use of all digital technologies from the making of the appointment to the insertion and maintenance of a restoration. This technology, when used properly, better serves to provide the patient with an improved dental experience. Technologies include office management systems and communications, digital photography, radiography and information gathering, charting, lasers, implant planning and placement, digital impression systems, digital fabrication of restorations and digital maintenance.

In addition, we shall provide information on the use of a dental laboratory in digitally fabricating dental restorations. This will include prep design, intra-oral scanning using E4D Dentist Solo, digital Rx and computer-aided design (CAD) restorations for *next day* delivery.

We anticipate having our digitally directed milling machine on-board for our audience to view the construction of a perfectly matched crown, produced solely from a digital picture. The latter is made by an optical scanner, E4D Dentist Solo. Thus, there is no need for the traditional impression. In practice, the digital photo is electronically transmitted from dental office to laboratory and the finished crown delivered 24 hours later.
