Anesthesia and Pain Control (Course Code 350, 1 Credit Hour), Oral Surgery (Course Code 310, 15 Credit hours)

This course will utilize some specially designed models that I feel reproduce the feel of real tissue, bone and teeth like I had never used before. We will cover a variety of surgical cases from extraction of a mandibular first molar and placement of the new ultra wide diameter implant, extraction of a Maxillary first molar, trans-alveolar sinus lift and immediate placement of the ultra wide diameter implant, extraction of tooth #8, with an immediate implant, immediate abutment, temporary tooth and graft. We will also cover soft tissue procedures of second stage uncovering and reconstruction of the interdental papilla on a molar with the new Contour plastic healing abutments, and a palatal roll soft tissue reconstruction in the esthetic zone. In addition to the model surgery, you will be shown related live surgical videos demonstrating these techniques.
