His experience is based on a dedication to the belief that "excellence" and "esthetics" are not only compatible, but can take dentistry to a new level of satisfaction and success.

The restorative dentist serves as the quarterback when establishing a comprehensive dental treatment plan. Spectacular esthetic results can be achieved by allowing the patient's face to dictate treatment. Once the desired end result is determined, the restorative dentist, orthodontist, and other team members work together to achieve long lasting, aesthetic, maintainable results that satisfy today's demanding patient expectations.

- Improving communication skills with the patient and team members.
- Altering tissue levels, the art of temporization and creatively cutting treatment time from years to months.

He received his Bachelor of Science (1975) and Doctor of Dental Surgery (1979) degree in general dentistry from McGill University. Dr. Mechanic is the esthetic editor of Canada's "Oral Health" dental journal and is on the editorial board of Dentistry Today. He also is the co-founder of the Canadian Academy for Esthetic Dentistry. He lectures worldwide on treatment planning, smile design, restorative dentistry and implantology.

Dr. Mechanic is a diplomate of the American Board of Esthetic Dentistry, Fellow of the European Society of Cosmetic Dentistry, Fellow of the International Academy of Dental Facial Esthetics, Fellow of the American College of Dentists, and maintains membership in the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists.

Dr. Mechanic is the author of more than twenty-five scientific articles, textbook chapters and the book, "Esthetic Dentistry/Smile Design: The Patient Guide", which has been published in 9 languages.
