Chemical Dependency-OSHA-and Infection Control

Course Description:

This presentation concentrates on the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Guidelines for Infection Control in Dental Health-Care Settings—2003. Attendees will learn what they should be doing to ensure a safe working environment for themselves and their patients. The evening portion will be reviewing the new street drugs affecting our area and possibly our own practices. You will be able to earn all required CE hours for licensure renewal in these specific areas at one time. This means less time away from your practice and home.

Course Objectives:

- Describe prevention strategies for occupational exposures.

- Describe current approaches intended to improve the quality of water used for dental treatment.
- Discuss special infection control considerations including dental infection-control program evaluation and management.

She provides guidance in dental infection control and occupational safety/health to over 900 federal dental service facilities. She was in private practice before beginning her career with the USAF. Dr. Harte has been responsible for the direct oversight of dental and medical infection control programs in military health-care clinical settings for over 16 years.

Mr. Hal Nevitt is currently the Director of the Member Assistance Program for the Arizona State Bar. His resume includes State licensure as a Social Worker and Independent Substance Abuse Councelor.
