Expecting the Unexpected: Management of Medical Emergencies in the Dental Office

COURSE OUTLINE

Emergencies can and do occur. Medical emergencies can pose a particular challenge for dentists. The presenting problems are inherently unexpected and the management of such issues is not something dentists typically practise on a regular basis. Familiarity with various medical emergencies that can occur and how to manage them is an important factor in achieving a safe and predictable outcome.
