Dr. Mancuso graduated from the University of Toronto in 1985 and has maintained a general dental practice in Welland, Ontario until 2016 when his daughter took over the practice.

In 2006 he received the award of Master in the Academy of General Dentistry and in 2011 he was recognized with the "Lifetime Learning and Service Recognition Award" by the AGD.

He has published articles for numerous dental journals and has given over 100 presentations to various dental organizations. In 2012 he was named, "Canadian AGD Dentist of the Year" by the Canadian AGD.

From 1999 to 2009, Dr. Mancuso conceived, developed and ran "Millennium Aesthetics"- a live hands-on program that taught dentists and staff aesthetic diagnosis and treatment.

In 2015 he served as Co-director for the University of Toronto, Continuing Education, Cosmetic Dentistry Mini-Residency program for practicing dentists. He was Scientific Co-Chair for CARDP for the 2015 and 2019 meetings.

He served as President of the Regional Niagara AGD study club for over 10 years.

Currently, he works 2 mornings a week doing what he does best!

MILLENNIUM AESTHETICS

REGISTRATION: 8:00AM - 8:30AM | COURSE: 8:30AM - 4:00PM

This course will discuss the implementation of aesthetic elective dentistry into the general dental practice setting. Diagnosis and treatment planning are at the heart of aesthetic elective treatment and will be covered in detail. Also, discussed will be preparation design, provisionalization, photography of the aesthetic case and insertion protocols. Lastly, practice management issues using internal marketing of aesthetic dentistry, will be discussed.

Participants will learn:

- 1) Diagnosis and treatment planning of aesthetic cases using the DAA form.
- 2) Photography for the Aesthetic Case
- 3) Preparation design principles for porcelain restorations
- 4) Provisionalization of aesthetic cases

Day 1 Hands-on: Participants will be diagnosing and treatment planning using the DAA form, then prepping and temporizing 1-2 cases using all the principles taught in this program.

- 5) Cementation technique for porcelain restorations especially porcelain veneers

Day 2 Hands-on: Participants will be bonding veneers on models utilizing the Rapid Cementation Technique

- 6) Internal marketing strategies to promote aesthetic procedures-practice management for aesthetic cases in the GP practice
