MAKING GOOD CHOICES IN ENDODONTIC MANAGEMENT Reciproc Blue Reciprocating NiTi Files For Canal Preparation

This presentation will address the various decisions for making good choices for endodontic management. Although new technologies have made endodontics easier, proper diagnosis and treatment planning are essential before endodontic treatment is initiated. The management of difficult endodontic cases involves problem solving and multidisciplinary considerations. Improving your endodontic knowledge will result in better treatment decisions and more predictable outcomes.

This presentation will describe the use of hand and reciprocating NiTi files for preparing root canals. Canal identification and negotiation will also be covered. Participants will prepare canals on extracted teeth using Reciproc Blue reciprocating NiTi files, and obturate these prepared canals using Gutta Core Conform Fit™ Gutta Percha. The use of the X-Smart Pro+ motor™ and SmartLite Pro Endo Activator™ will be utilized to prepare and disinfect root canals. The Contemporary management of routine and challenging cases, and assessment of post-treatment outcomes will be presented.



Dr. Coil received his undergraduate, dental and doctorate degrees from the University of British Columbia. He practiced general dentistry for 8 years and was a Clinical Instructor in Endodontics and Periodontics, before obtaining his certificate in Endodontics at the University of Washington in 1993.

He serves as an editorial consultant for the Journal of the Canadian Dental Association and on the Scientific Advisory Board for the Journal of Endodontics. He is a past President of the Canadian Academy of Endodontics and British Columbia Society of Endodontists, and is a member of the American Association of Endodontists.

Dr. Coil is the mentor and founder of the Northwest Endodontic Study Club and Seminar, and for the past 18 years, has been the Director of the Graduate Endodontics Program, Department of Oral Biological and Medical Sciences, University of British Columbia.
