He is the co-author of Color Atlas of Tongue Tie and Lip Tie Laser Frenectomy – the first textbook in the world on the subject.

Deepithelialization

- •Will be familiar with the various wavelengths used in dentistry today

- •Will understand their uses for specific oral diseases and pathologies found in everyday practice.
