COURSE OUTLINE

Fear and anxiety are among the most common reasons patients avoid dental treatment. This course will allow dentists to incorporate sedation into their daily practice to make patients more comfortable with treatment. Participants will learn how to safely and effectively administer nitrous oxide and/or oral sedation. This course also includes a section on medical emergencies in the dental office.
