### Morning Topic:

#### Treatment Planning & Sequencing of Comprehensive Cases; Practical Applications

#### Synopsis:

Many factors must be taken into consideration when treatment planning complex comprehensive cases. These factors range from occlusion and esthetics to Materials and soft tissue management. This presentation will help improve both efficiency and predictability by addressing the areas of concern that can be the most frustrating for clinicians. Based on the patient's needs and expectations, the treatment planning and sequencing often requires that treatment be phased without compromising the overall outcome. In addition to learning to treat large complex cases "all at once," a systematic approach will be presented to allow the phasing of comprehensive treatment.

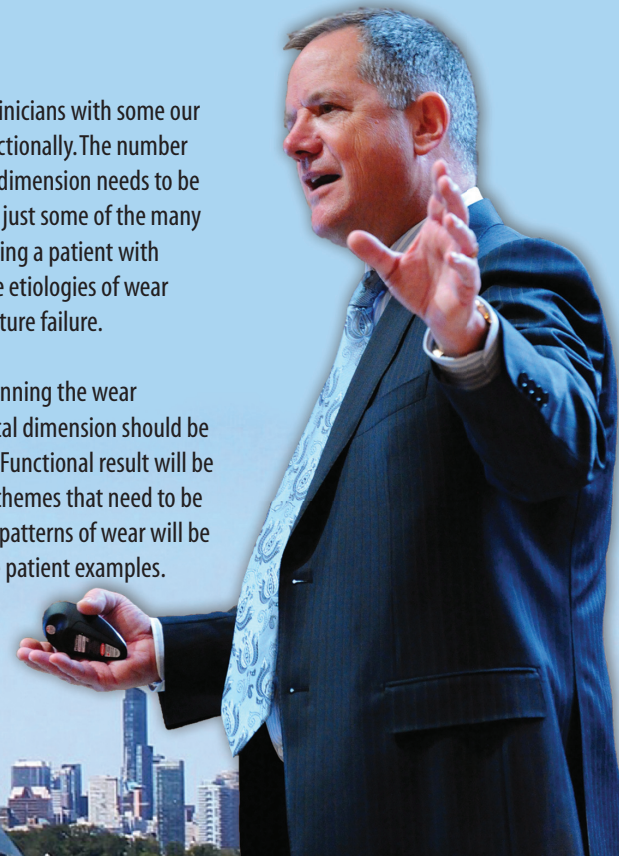
### Afternoon Topic:

#### Diagnosing, treatment planning and treating Esthetics & Function in patients with severe tooth wear

#### Synopsis:

Patients with significant tooth wear present clinicians with some of our greatest challenges both Esthetically and Functionally. The number of teeth needing treatment, whether vertical dimension needs to be altered, the risk of future wear and failure, are just some of the many questions that we must address when managing a patient with significant wear. This program will address the etiologies of wear and how to differentiate the risk factors for future failure.

A step-by-step methodology of treatment planning the wear patient, including when and how a new vertical dimension should be established to optimize the final Esthetic and Functional result will be presented. In addition the different occlusal schemes that need to be considered depending upon the etiology and patterns of wear will be addressed. All will be illustrated with multiple patient examples.
