Aesthetic Dentistry in the GP Office from A to Z

COURSE OUTLINE

This course will discuss the implementation of aesthetic elective dentistry into the general dental practice setting. Diagnosis and treatment planning are at the heart of aesthetic elective treatment and will be covered in detail. Also, discussed will be preparation design, provisionalization, and insertion protocols. Lastly, practice management issues using internal marketing of aesthetic dentistry, will be discussed.

- 2. Preparation design principles for porcelain restorations.
- 3. Provisionalization of veneer cases.
