DR. KARL KOERNER, BS, DDS, MS

Dr. Koerner presents basic oral surgery instruction to General Dentists to improve their knowledge, expertise, and production. He is an Associate Professor in Oral Surgery at Roseman College of Dental Medicine in Utah, USA but also teaches courses around the country to groups large and small, didactic and hands-on. This one is hands-on with life-like dentofacial models where participants do eight extractions including upper and lower 1st molars, upper and lower easier wisdom teeth, and multiple extractions with roots breaking and even a root tip on the edge of the sinus. Several other surgery topics are also covered (see bullet points). As a GP he has done only surgery for the last 20 years, having been trained in the U.S. Army. He is past president of the Utah AGD and Utah Dental Association and has received awards from the National AGD and Utah Dental Association. He does teaching and humanitarian work in China (organized 18 trips) and Honduras. He is Co-founder of the Koerner Institute for Surgical Instruction in Dallas, TX.

Graduated from University of Detroit Mercy for his dental program. He then completed a 1-year General Practice Residency program at the Miami Valley Hospital in Dayton Ohio. He practiced general dentistry for 13 years then return to complete his postgraduate training in the specialty of Prosthodontics at the University Of Toronto.
