COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a 3-day Oral Surgery skills course for the GP. What makes this course different is that it focuses on low risk high return procedures including impacted wisdom teeth, complicated extractions, grafting and implants. You will learn not only the hands-on techniques but how to perform staged surgeries that compliment each other such as atraumatic complicated extractions coupled with surgical site preservation using Platelet Rich Fibrin techniques and subsequent implant placement. Fundamental skills including purpose specific flap design, closure options and procedure specific post-op management will be reviewed. Lab based hands-on exercises will allow you to practice hard tissue surgery, soft tissue surgery including biopsies and Platelet Rich Fibrin protocols. You will learn enough theory to make good evidence-based clinical decisions but the emphasis will be on hands-on skills."
