Nitrous Oxide Sedation for the Anxious Dental Patient – A Review

COURSE OUTLINE

This one-day nitrous oxide sedation course is aimed at reviewing nitrous oxide equipment and technique. Emphasis will be placed on understanding equipment, importance of scavenging, proper technique with incremental dosing to desired level of sedation and troubleshooting problems. Medical emergencies, as they pertain to nitrous oxide sedation, will be reviewed. Recordkeeping requirements will also be discussed.

This course is intended as a review for practitioners already administering nitrous oxide sedation in their practice. This is NOT a certification course in nitrous oxide sedation.



Dr. Ravi Vasudeva is a specialist in Dental Anesthesia with the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario. He received his dental degree from the University of Toronto and went on to complete a one-year General Practice Residency at Rochester General Hospital, in Rochester, New York.
